



### Pioneer Oval

- 13 Construct a new 500 seat grandstand and amenities building to incorporate player/ referee change rooms, officials' rooms, media boxes, and multipurpose room with kitchenette. Incorporate a plaza behind the stand with a theme showcasing the history of Pioneer Oval as a venue for rugby league (Jock Colley)
- 14 Expand and upgrade the canteen
- 15 Investigate an alternate use for the existing amenities building (or remove)
- 16 Formalise the car park and access to the proposed new grandstand, including drop-off and pick-up zone
- 17 Warm-up field
- 18 New scoreboard

### Northparkes Oval

- 19 Install covered terraced seating
- 20 New BBQ and shelter
- 21 Install industrial standard carpet in the clubroom
- 22 Redevelop or expand the canteen area to accommodate increased storage
- 23 Improve external lighting around the building
- 24 Construct a path from the building to the athletics field event area
- 25 Replace the sand in the long jump and triple jump pits, and purchase tarpaulin covers for the pits of two of the three jump runways
- 26 Resolve the drainage issues
- 27 New scoreboard
- 28 Reconstruct the access road to accommodate two-way traffic
- 29 New gatekeeper shelter
- 30 Undertake native tree planting at Northparkes Oval

### General precinct Upgrades

- 31 Install a 2.5m chain-mesh fence along Alexandra Street
- 32 Install a 2.5m chain-mesh fence between Northparkes Oval and Pioneer Oval
- 33 Install a drop-off and pick-up zone
- 34 Install a 2.5m chain-mesh fence east of the reconfigured Spicer oval
- 35 Install a precinct perimeter path network, including occasional bench seating, and which could be used as an offroad running track (consider naming the track 'Scott Westcott Track')

### Spicer Oval

- 1 Reconfigure and expand Spicer Oval to accommodate two rugby fields
- 2 Relocate the turf cricket table between the two fields
- 3 Install new floodlighting to rugby field 1
- 4 Demolish the grandstand and replace the building with a new amenities block, canteen and public toilets
- 5 New multiuse store for the sporting clubs
- 6 Remove the public toilet, and construct a new car park by utilising unused land in Pioneer Oval
- 7 Realign the fence
- 8 New entry treatment for Spicer Oval, including gatekeeper shelter
- 9 New scoreboard
- 10 Install paths to link Spicer Oval to the broader precinct path network
- 11 Install indented car parking (15 spaces)
- 12 Use stabilised grass to form an overflow car park area

- Continue to utilise areas within Spicer Oval and Pioneer Oval for overflow camping and caravans during major events
- Increase the power supply to the precinct
- Repair degraded embankments with landscaping
- Install directional signage and functional signage throughout the precinct
