





4. Grant funds attracted

- \$6,641,933 secured with assistance by the Grants Officers this quarter.
- \$92,639,176 worth of grants are still pending outcome.
- 44 grant submissions were lodged worth **\$18,791,855**.

5. Outcomes and benefits of successful applications

- \$3,316,627 to Parkes Shire Council under the Community Assets Program for four projects: PAC Park rehabilitation and foot bridges in Parkes; Restabilise Bushman's Dam in Parkes; Berryman Oval pool pump and car park in Trundle; New SES Complex for Parkes.
- \$12,500 to the Old Trundle General Store under the Local Heritage Grants Program
- \$20,000 to the Trundle Community Gym under the Elders Community Giving Project
- \$500 to the Parkes Wiradjuri Language Group from the Trees for Bees grant to plant native trees at the Wiradjuri garden, Bushman Hill
